Description:

Guided tour of a roofing system fabricating facility. Includes a summary of the manufacturing processes, quality checks, inspection procedures, and testing performed within the facility to conform to UL, FM and regulatory codes. A conference room session describes the theory, rationale and application of the roofing system.

Learning Objectives:

At the end of this presentation participants will: 1) understand the processes involved in manufacturing a custom pre-fabricated roofing system utilizing a thermoplastic roofing membrane and its components; 2) understand some of the testing and inspection processes required; 3) have a basic knowledge of system installation.

How taught:

This program includes a walking tour performed by an in-house expert on manufacturing operations. Interactive participation utilizes on-site observation, material samples, program handouts, video and demonstrations to enhance the learning experience for participants.

Architects, engineers, specifiers, building owners, building managers, contractors, or other design and construction professionals. Ideal class size is 20 – 30, however, larger or smaller groups may be accommodated. Tours are divided into groups of 6 – 10.
